The Candela Vbeam produces an intense but gentle burst of light that treats abnormal blood vessels and redness of the skin without harming the surrounding tissue. I understand that no guarantee can be given as to the final results obtained. I am aware that while some individuals may experience significant improvement, it is possible that these treatments may not work for me.
